## Speaker Qualities

## Voice

- 1. Speaks to softly or just right?
- 2. Enunciates clearly?
- 3. Speaks too quickly or too slowly or just right?

## Introduction

- 1. Does the introduction grab your attention immediately?
- 2. Is the introduction relevant to the topic of the talk?
- 3. Should the introduction be shorter or longer or leave as is?

### Body of Talk

- 1. Does the talk follow the outline? If not, what points were omitted? Are the omitted points relevant?
- 2. Does the talk do what it is intended to do? (Compare to Talk Reviews and Discussion Helps in you team booklet.)
- 3. Does the talk flow in a logical pattern and to a logical conclusion?
- 4. Does personal testimony support the talk not vice versa?
- 5. Does the talk challenge the guests to reflect and ask introspective questions?
- 6. Was God glorified and biblical truths shared?

### <u>Conclusion</u>

- 1. Are the main points of the talk pulled together at the end?
- 2. At conclusion will guests have a springboard for further discussion?
- 3. Time preview at 25 minutes, talk will be 30 minutes during weekend.
